We hope you're having a great summer and are excited for another season of soccer.

As the new Tournament Directors for the Falmouth Fall Classic, we wanted to introduce ourselves. We are Stacy Salvo and Allie Seelan, and we're honored to be leading the planning of the 31st Annual Falmouth Fall Classic. As we step into this role, we appreciate your patience as we work through any first-year adjustments. Our goal is simple: to build on the tournament's strong tradition while delivering a fun, competitive, and well-organized experience for players, coaches, families, and referees alike.

A Focus on Quality

The Falmouth Fall Classic continues to be one of Maine's most popular youth soccer tournaments. Given the high demand each year, we have carefully evaluated the tournament format and facilities to ensure the best possible experience for all participants.

Based on feedback from prior years and facility limitations, we will be accepting fewer teams than in recent years, with a target of approximately 186 teams. This will allow us to ensure age-appropriate regulation field and goal sizes, adequate time between games, improved scheduling, and an overall higher-quality tournament experience.

As a result of these improvements, there will be a modest increase in registration fees this year.

Registration Process

Registration Opens: June 26 at 8:00 AM

Teams can register online through the Falmouth Fall Classic website:

You will receive a confirmation email once your application has been submitted. Teams will be notified of their acceptance status by Friday, July 24th.

First-come, **first-considered**: To create balanced and competitive divisions, teams will be considered in the order registrations are received, however, acceptance is not strictly first-come, first-served.

Official rosters are not required at the time of registration.

2026 Registration Fees

U9-U10

\$400 per team

- Two 40-minute games, played either Saturday or Sunday

U11

\$500 per team

- Three games played across Saturday and Sunday

U12-U14

\$600 per team

- Three games across Saturday and Sunday
- Opportunity to advance to Monday playoff matches

Team Placement

We will work hard to create competitive and enjoyable matchups for every team. However, please note that we cannot guarantee that Division 2 or lower-tier teams will be matched exclusively with teams of similar competitive levels. Some variation in competition is expected in a tournament setting.

That said, our goal remains to create balanced brackets that provide challenging, fair, and enjoyable games for all participants.

Given the popularity of the Falmouth Fall Classic and the limited number of available spots, we encourage clubs to register as early as possible.

Thank you for your continued support of the tournament. We look forward to welcoming your teams to Falmouth this October and celebrating the 31st year of the Falmouth Fall Classic together.
